About HAEP

TalentGro, the Workforce Development Division of Hamilton-Ryker, and Argentum a Long Term Care Facility Membership organization, assembled a consortium of healthcare providers to apply for the “Apprenticeships: Closing the Skills Gaps” US DOL Federal Grant.

In collaboration with additional employers and educators, our proposed program was awarded nearly \$6M in grant funds for HAEP to:

- Launch at least two new programs and expand nine existing apprenticeship paths.

What’s in it for our Employer Partners

We have several large scale employers who submitted letters of support to participate in the grant. Now that the grant is awarded, we are working on the needs and roles identified in the application process. We are also identifying other healthcare providers who could benefit from the Grant.

Services offered through HAEP

- ✓ Application for Registered Apprenticeship Program
- ✓ Provide wrap-around services through Family Scholar House
- ✓ Connect business and RTI (education providers) and volume price opportunities
- ✓ Ease Administrative Burden: Liaison and reporting with DOL
- ✓ Local, State and Federal Applications and approvals. Coordination of additional Funding Sources
- ✓ Programmatic awareness



Here’s how it works:

- Participating providers define on-the-job training and related technical instruction for employees enrolled as apprentices.
- Apprentices who complete the requirements earn a defined pay raise and/or promotion at each credential or level.
- Employers sign on to the national program (employer agreement).
- Employees register with their employer as apprentices (apprenticeship agreement).

- Serve 7,239 healthcare workers
 - 2,300 new hires
 - 3,955 incumbent workers moving into new roles
